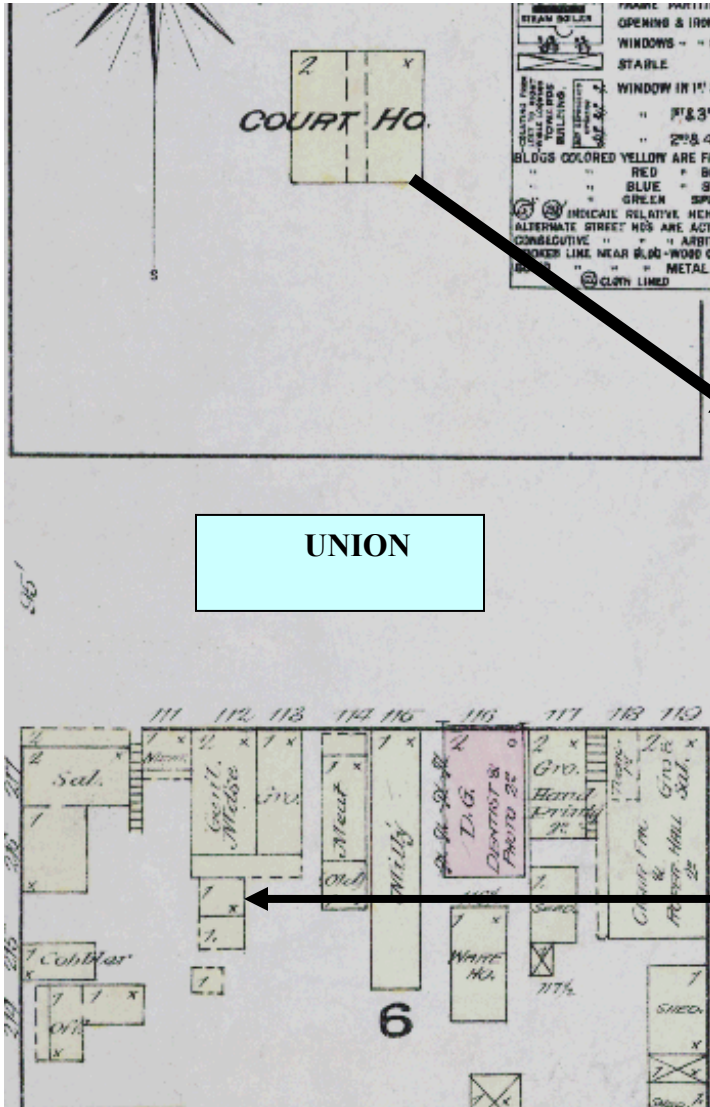

all that certain lot, piece, tract or parcel of land situated, lying and being in the County of Alachua, State of Florida, particularly known and described as follows, to wit:
Lots (7) Berry and (8) Leigh in Veitch's addition to Gainesville as
according to survey made by W C Miller situated in the NW 1/4 Section
Nine (9) Township ten (10) Range (10) East, which map is of Record in the
Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of said County

containing by estimation *1/2 one half* acre of land, more or less. Together with all and singular the tenements, appurtenances and appertinences to the same belonging, or in anywise appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto *him* the said *Gilbert H Brown*

and *his* heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, in the single absolute. And *Ms* the said *Hattie A Veitch and W H Veitch*

do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said *Gilbert H Brown*

that *Ms* lawfully acted in fee of the property herein said hereby conveyed, and that *Ms* have good and lawful right to sell and convey the same; that the same is free from all encumbrances of whatever nature, and that *Ms* will and *Ms* heirs, executors and administrators shall and will forever warrant and defend the same unto *him* the said *Gilbert H Brown*

and to *his* heirs, executors and administrators and assigns, against the lawful claims and demands of any and all persons whatsoever now existing or hereafter to claim the same.
