Abstract

- Definition: a summary of the content of the resource.
- Attributes
 - type
 - displayLabel
 - lang
- Examples:

AccessCondition

- Definition: information about restrictions imposed on access to a resource
- Attributes
 - type (suggested value: *restriction on access ; use and reproduction*)
 - displayLabel
 - lang
- Example:

Identifier

- Definition: unique standard number or code that distinctively identifies a resource.
- Attributes

Language

- Definition: a designation of the language in which the content of a resource is expressed
 - SubElements

Location

- Definition: Identifies the institution or repository holding the resource, or a remote location in the form of a URL

OriginInfo

- Definition: Information about the origin of the resource, including place of origin or publication, publisher/originator, and dates associated with the resource

 - copyrightDate
 - place
 - SubElements
 - placeTerm
 - Attributes
 - type (*code, text*)
 - authority (*marccountry, iso3166*)

- Definition: A word, phrase, character, or group of characters, normally appearing in a resource, that names it or the work contained in it.

TypeOfResource

- Definition: A term that specifies the characteristics and general typ of content of this resource
- Value is from a controlled list
 - mixed material

- sound recording
 - text
 - cartographic
 - still image
 - moving image
 - three dimensional object

Unused MODS Elements

The following standard MODS elements are not utilized by UFDC.

- **Genre**
 - Definition: term(s) that designates a category characterizing a particular style, form, or content, such as artistic, musical, literary composition, etc.
 - *We have actually been using this wrong I think. Genre means the genre of the object, which is somewhat different than the genre in the subject keywords.*
- **TableOfContents**
 - *No reason to use this; we package these MODS into a complete METS which houses the table of contents in the structMap element.*
- **Classification**
 - Definition: a designation applied to a resource that indicates the subject by applying a formal system of coding and organizing resources according to subject areas.
- **Extension**
 - Definition: "extension" is used to provide for additional information not covered by MODS. It may be used for elements that are local to the creator of the data, similar to MARC 21 9XX fields. In addition, it may be used to extend MODS for various purposes when another XML schema may handle the type of information. For instance, holdings information for the resource may be included in <extension> with a link to an XML holdings schema
 - *No reason to use this; we store this information in the complete METS which uses other extension schema*

- **RecordInfo**

- Definition: information about the metadata record.
- *No reason to use this; we store this information in the complete METS*
