Nota histórica/biográfica

La Dra. Helen Safa, (1930-2013), fue Profesora Emérita de Antropología y de Estudios Latinoamericanos de la Universidad de Florida. Sirvió como directora del Centro de Estudios Latinoamericanos de la Universidad de Florida; como presidente de la Asociación de Estudios Latinoamericanos, y enseñó en la Universidad de Rutgers, y la Universidad de Syracuse. En el 2007, recibió el premio de por vida Kalman Silvert por logros en estudios sobre América Latina. Dra. Safa publicó monografías, más de cien artículos sobre género, raza, desarrollo, urbanización, pobreza, migración, movimientos sociales y políticas del estado, y coeditó libros. Muchos de sus estudios se consideran clásicos en los campos de urbanismo y antropología feminista, incluyendo sus libros *The Urban Poor of Puerto Rico* y *The Myth of the Male Breadwinner: Women and Industrialization in the Caribbean*. La Dra. Safa está incluida en la colección digital Women in Development de las colecciones digitales de la Universidad de Florida.
