## Nota histórica/biográfica

Miguel Ángel Quevedo de la Lastra (1908-1969), era el dueño, editor, y publicador de *Bohemia*, la revista más importante de Cuba, de 1927 al 1960. *Bohemia* fue fundada en 1908 por Miguel Ángel Quevedo Pérez, padre de Miguel Ángel Quevedo. Históricamente, *Bohemia* publicaba críticas a los gobiernos cubanos y presidentes dictatoriales, incluyendo Fulgencio Batista. En 1960, Miguel Ángel Quevedo y su hermana, Rosa Margarita Quevedo, se fueron de Cuba luego de pedir asilo en Venezuela. La colección contiene materiales relacionados principalmente con este tiempo, incluyendo correspondencia personal luego de la muerte de Miguel Ángel Quevedo por suicidio en 1968. Algunos materiales están datados posteriores a esta fecha, y estos consisten en correspondencia personal de Rosa Margarita Quevedo.
